Waste paper

- Newspapers
 - Newspaper supplements
 - Magazines
 - Brochures
 - Leaflets
 - Writing paper
 - Recycled paper
- } all without plastic covers
- Computer listing paper
 - Notepaper
 - Telephone directories
 - Books without spines
 - Catalogues
 - Photocopies
 - Household envelopes

Cardboard

The cardboard industry accepts the following for recycling

- Industrial envelopes
- Fruit and vegetable boxes (preferably without adhesive plastic strips)
- Corrugated boxes (preferably without adhesive plastic strips)
- Paper carrier bags
- Cardboard boxes
- Egg cartons
- Shredded paper
- Scraps of paper

Waste

The paper and cardboard industry does **not** accept the following for recycling

- Plastic
- Milk cartons
- Flower-wrapping
- Fruit juice cartons
- Labels and other stickers
- Soup packets
- Detergent boxes
- Frozen food boxes
- Dirty paper
- Aluminium biscuit wrappers
- Dirty cardboard
- Wet-strength paper
- Any type of waste, clothing, etc.
- Plastic-coated paper



Recycle right

Please recycle waste paper and cardboard separately. Information on local and regional collection points can be obtained from municipalities and waste-paper disposal companies or the Association of the Swiss Pulp, Paper and Board Industry (ZPK), PO box 134, 8030 Zurich, www.zpk.ch. Please ask your local waste-paper collector what you can and can't recycle.
